How Do I Register?: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15: Come to our Orchestra Registration Night, which will be

held in the Orchestra Room (1635) at Niles North High School (park on the North side of the school and walk to the West side to enter through Door 19). Here, students will be able to try out the instruments and choose what they would like to play. The music store, Cassandra Strings, will be available for instrument rentals as well. Instrument: Students will need to rent an instrument for use at rehearsals and performances.

> Recommended stores to rent from include (but not limited to): Cassandra Strings, Seman Violins, Quinlan and Fabish. It is not recommended that students purchase an instrument until they are a bit older and playing on a full size instrument. Please let Mrs. Page know if you have any concerns with renting an instrument. Instruments may be provided for

students in need.
