### **Program Overview**

Welcome to Meyer's Afterschool Enrichment Program, **Enrich MEYER**. We are excited to provide Meyer Kindergarten students with a variety of unique courses that focus on particular areas of interest.

**Enrich MEYER** Afterschool Enrichment courses engage Kindergarten students in hands-on learning that help them learn and practice new concepts in different ways. All courses are hosted **In-Person** at Meyer and take place after school between September 19 and December 1, 2022. Each course runs one day per week, and students may enroll in a different course each day.

### **Fees and Scholarships**

Please note, enrichment classes are included in fee waivers. If you have a fee waiver for this school year please mark that on your registration form.

### **Withdrawals & Refunds**

Students who withdraw from the entirety of Enrich MEYER due to medical emergencies or other extenuating circumstances will be provided a refund of tuition fees paid. Absences for individual days or sessions cannot be refunded, **including absences due to quarantine**.

### **Course Cancellation**

Each course has an enrollment limit dependent upon the activity. Courses that do not reach the minimum class size may be canceled.

### **Emergency Class Cancellation**

There may be times when it becomes necessary to cancel enrichment classes. We may be unable to notify you in advance, for example, if a teacher is absent or in the instance of severe weather. In the case that a class is canceled, we will contact the parent/guardian as soon as we are aware, and we will work out a dismissal plan.

### **COVID-19 Safety Protocols**

### **Dismissal**

Tuesday Enrich MEYER classes end at 3:00 p.m., and Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday Enrich MEYER classes end at 3:30 p.m. A parent/guardian or parent-approved adult **should come to Door 6 to pick up their child**. Students who attend SPACE will be escorted to the After school SPACE program.

With the coming of the winter months, we will draw and celebrate with a nutcracker that takes his job very seriously. All these (and many more exciting lessons!) while we enhance our fine-motor skills, learn to stay on task and follow directions, and learn the discrimination skills so critical in the classroom!

Our fall session is dedicated to learning all about chemical reactions. Students will learn how to identify a chemical reaction. We will conduct fun experiments involving color changing, making things foam, and changing color and shape. At the end of the course, students will understand pH levels, non-Newtonian fluid, what a catalyst is, and so much more! Our young scientists are encouraged to ask questions, think critically, experiment, and explain their reasoning and problem-solving. As a result, they will deepen their collaboration, creativity, and critical thinking skills, as well as their understanding and interest in science.

**Discovery Language: Spanish****[www.discovery-language.com](http://www.discovery-language.com)**

Discovery Language Programs, a non-for profit educational organization that has been conducting enrichment foreign language programs to students in Preschool and Elementary School since 1992.

Our curriculum has been carefully developed by educational specialists in the field of foreign language instruction. Discovery teaching method uses a natural, oral approach with gradual immersion. Students build oral language skills through games, songs and hands-on activities. Reading and writing skills are also introduced when age appropriate.

By participating in Discovery Language Programs children can experience other cultures and become aware of multicultural issues. They can also increase their academic skills in history, geography, reading, writing, and the knowledge of their own language.

Learning a new language is always an exciting adventure, a real “Discovery” of a whole new world and the people in it. Children are most receptive to foreign language learning between birth and age twelve. The earlier a foreign language is introduced, the more easily a greater level of understanding and fluency is achieved.

Every lesson in the DLP Curriculum has the same structure. Children enter the class and sit in a circle on the floor (rug/carpet). Instructor always starts the class by singing a song, usually the “Greeting Song”,. The song means that class is starting, and everybody is listening.

Children succeed when they have routine and structure. Language acquisition increases when children are able to take risks and experiment with language—and that happens when they are in a safe and comfortable environment. The DLP Curriculum creates this by providing a consistent routine and structure. Students can predict what is going to happen next, and they know what is expected of them. Students are very young, and the teacher needs to keep them interested at all times. In the first few months the children will become familiar with the sounds and characteristics of the new language they are starting to learn. They will understand simple commands and questions as well as the little vocabulary that has been introduced. They will not be able to form sentences or come up with answers in the target language. This class is designed to be a fun, rewarding experience in preparation for future learning.
